Implementation of Emergency Bunker Surcharge

Dear Valued Customers,

The continued rise in global bunker fuel costs driven by recent geopolitical developments has made it necessary for Pacific International Lines (PIL) to implement an Emergency Bunker Surcharge (EBS), as part of our efforts to maintain the reliability and sustainability of our service network.

Scope of Application

- **Trades:** All Long-Haul Trades
- **Cargo Type:** Dry and Reefer

Service Scope	Dry (USD/TEU)	Reefer (USD/TEU)
Into LATAM, Red Sea, Gulf/ISC, Africa and Oceania destinations	160	240
Out of LATAM, Red Sea, Gulf/ISC, Africa and Oceania regions	80	120

The EBS will apply to **outbound sailings commencing on or after 23 March 2026**, subject to approval by the relevant local regulatory authorities where required.
